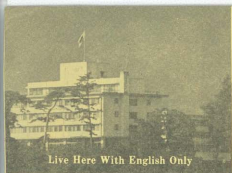
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BETTER LIKE MAP OF THE WORLD

## PLACE

This Intensive English Training Course will be given in the Odawara Asian Center at Odawara in Kanagawa Prefecture. Here there are study and lecture rooms, an English library, a Sony Language Laboratory, dining rooms and bedrooms, all looking out on the Hakone Mountains and the Pacific Ocean. The Center can be reached from Odawara Station by taxi in 10 minutes.

## WHO CAN ATTEND?

The most important requirement is a determination to learn living English for use in work, in study and in every kind of communication with people. Those who want to enter this course should already be able to participate in simple English conversation. Acceptance will be decided by interview and written examination.
